### ABOUT THE APPRENTICESHIP

#### Apprenticeship & Qualification Level

- This is a level 4 apprenticeship and depending on your work setting can be completed with either the Level 3 Diploma in Residential Childcare or Certificate in Higher Education in working with Children, Young People and Families.

#### Duration

- 18-24 months

#### Progression

- Manager roles

#### Learning Methods

- Each apprentice will have a dedicated tutor who will arrange contact on at least a monthly basis.
- The employer may also arrange a mentor.
- Tutorials and learning resources are online and can be accessed from any device

#### Employer Requirements

- Each employer will set their own requirements.
- Each Apprentice must complete an Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check before starting

#### Study Requirements

- If the apprentice does not have maths and English GCSE passes at grade C or above, they will need to pass maths and English Functional Skills level 2 during their Apprenticeship.
- The apprentice will need to complete an End Point Assessment to demonstrate they are competent in the role.
